Welcome to Fornæs Camping!

In general, Fornæs Camping is against restrictive regulations and we prefer to believe in common sense. But it can be nice to have a set of rules that provides answers to most questions. We would like to give praise to those of our guests who are with us for the entire season, for the positive way in which they always welcome other guests on the campsite. This is an essential prerequisite so that they go home with a positive overall impression of their holiday stay at Fornæs Camping. If you are in doubt, then ask us!

Rules for renting a space for the season:

- 1. The most important rule is to show consideration towards others in a situation where we live relatively close and use common service facilities. Always leave the common facilities clean and tidy after use.
- 2. A seasonal space is valid for parents as well as children under the age of 18 who are still living at home. If you want to invite people or lend the caravan to someone, the office must be notified, and guests must pay the applicable accommodation rates for adults and children. If you have children over the age of 18 or foster children that regularly drop by to visit, we can agree on a special price.
- 3. Guest cards can be purchased at the office and are only valid for a maximum of 6 persons per time. If you have several guests visiting at the same time, the guest entrance is to be paid by contacting the office.
- 4. The rented space must be kept nice and tidy at all times, this mean that the renter must mow the grass around the caravan and awning and clean areas surrounding the space. If this is not possible for the renter due to health reasons or other factors, he or she shall contact the office to find a solution for the task for a fee. Mowers and other garden tools can be borrowed from the office.
- 5. Only seasonal spaces spring/summer/autumn may set up a storage tent of approx. 3 m² after prior authorization.
- 6. The renter may not transfer his or her rights or sub-rent the seasonal space to a third party.
- 7. All driving on the grounds must be at a walking speed, max. 10 km/hour. Driving on the grounds between 10:00 PM and
 - 7:00 AM is not allowed.
- 8. Making shortcuts through other camping spaces, planting and hedges is not allowed, nor cutting or pruning these. Roads and paths should be used also by the young camping guests.
- 9. The garbage containers set up on the grounds site map may only be used for ordinary kitchen waste, bottles, cardboard and similar. All other waste (old chairs, refrigerators, carpets, awnings, awnings, floorboards, etc.) MUST be removed by the renter himself/herself. Please use the municipal waste dump on Kalorievej 2, 8500 Grenå. The small waste bins that are placed near the service buildings are only intended for small waste. not for kitchen garbage bags, empty bottles, cans, etc.
- 10. The camping space must be quiet at 11:00 PM.
- 11. Apart from cases in which a violation is involved, the rental agreement is non-terminable by both parties during the agreed period of time. If a renter decides to leave earlier, the renter cannot demand a refund or reimbursement.
- 12. Digging in the ground is not allowed, i.e. planting shrubs, flowers and similar. A small number of potted plants may be set up near the caravan. Garden gazebos must not be permanent and the flag poles may only be mounted on a trailer hitch.
- 13. The seasonal camping space must be tidy and clean on the day the rental agreement terminates. Winter storage is possible against payment.
- 14. Dogs and cats are welcome, but must be kept on a leash on the camping space and walked outside the camping space remember dog bags in the event of an accident. Pets must not disturb the neighbors.
- 15. The renter is obliged to report both day guests and overnight guests immediately upon their arrival. Guests are to park in the parking lot. There may be only one car per camping space, and unnecessary driving should be avoided.
- 16. The water taps on the camping space may only be used for drinking water. Waste water must not be poured in the sewer, but must be disposed of in the emptying room.
